Description: Provides funding directly to law enforcement agencies to hire and/or rehire additional career law enforcement officers in an effort to increase their community policing capacity and crime prevention efforts. Anticipated outcomes of the COPS Hiring Program awards include engagement in planned community partnerships, implementation of projects to analyze and assess problems, implementation of changes to personnel and agency management in support of community policing, and increased capacity of agency to engage in community policing activities.

Safer Outcomes: Enhancing De-Escalation and Crisis Response Training for Law Enforcement - Support for Law Enforcement Agencies

Description: Provides funding to law enforcement agencies to promote safe outcomes during police encounters with persons in crisis through relevant training.

Awards will be made to law enforcement agencies seeking to implement training and related supports. Training is supported for law enforcement officers, support personnel employed by law enforcement agencies, campus public safety officers, and mental health professionals working on

a crisis intervention team as an employee of a law enforcement agency or under a legal agreement with a law enforcement agency.

School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP)

Description: Provides funding directly to states, units of local government, Indian tribes, and public agencies (school districts, public boards of education, police departments, and sheriffs' departments) to improve security at schools and on school grounds in the grantees' jurisdictions through evidence-based school safety programs and technology.

Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS)



Deadline: This grant application window is currently closed. Please <u>sign up</u> to receive email notifications for updates on grant opportunities.

Description: Provides funding to improve public safety and victim services in tribal communities. This provides federally recognized tribes and tribal consortia an opportunity to apply for funding to aid in developing a comprehensive and coordinated approach to public safety. Many of the U.S. Department of Justice's existing tribal government-specific programs are included in and available through this single coordinated funding opportunity.

STOP School Violence Program



Deadline: This grant application window is currently closed. Please <u>sign up</u> to receive email notifications for updates on grant opportunities.

Description: Provides funding to support school safety by implementing solutions to enhance school climate, establish school-based behavioral threat assessment and intervention teams to identify violence risks, introduce technologies like anonymous reporting tools, and apply other evidence-based strategies to prevent violence. The goal is to equip K–12 students, teachers, and staff with tools to recognize, respond to, and prevent acts of violence.

Community-Based Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative Site-Based

Description: Provides funding to prevent and reduce violent crime through comprehensive, evidence-informed violence intervention programs focused on those at highest risk. These programs include efforts to address gang and gun violence using community violence intervention strategies based on partnerships among community residents, local government agencies, victim service providers, community-based organizations, law enforcement, hospitals, researchers, and other community stakeholders.

Strategies to Support Children Exposed to Violence



Deadline: This grant application window is currently closed. Please <u>sign up</u> to receive email notifications for updates on grant opportunities.

Description: Provides funding to communities to develop coordinated and comprehensive community-based approaches to help children and their families who are exposed to violence (CEV) build resilience, restore their safety, heal their social and emotional wounds, and prevent future violence and delinquency. Funding can be used to develop and/or enhance support services for children exposed to violence to reduce the adverse impact of violence on youth,

families, and communities, and to help family-serving organizations better recognize and help families at risk for exposure to violence; and support multidisciplinary or coalition-building efforts to enhance communities' responses to CEV.

Description: Provides funding to support targeted efforts to address youth violence through implementing evidence-based prevention and intervention efforts in a school-based setting (K–12th grade only). The goals of the program are to (1) reduce the incidence of school violence through improved school safety and climate and (2) prevent youth violence, delinquency, and victimization in the targeted community.
